- 1.2.5 Assessing the statistical needs of the country in line with international standards, establishing and maintaining a national data bank through collecting and processing data using modern equipments and disseminate statistical data to the users and stakeholders according to their needs;
- 1.2.6 Establishing, maintaining and updating national data base and building a statistical network and strengthening it by establishing and using a digital archive for this purpose;
- 1.2.7 Arranging national and international cooperation on statistical issues in the area of education, training and research, undertaking certain cooperation programme and its expansion to develop professionalism and improvement of standards; and
- 1.2.8 Establishing and operating a central Geographical Information System (GIS) through formulating non discriminatory Geo coding system.

3.0 Poverty and Gender Reporting

3.1 Impact of Strategic Objectives on Poverty Reduction and Women's Advancement

3.1.1 Improvement of a international standard Statistical system/method

Impact on Poverty Reduction: Household Income and Expenditure Survey (HIES), a significant and regular activity of Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS), helps determining the poverty situation of Bangladesh and is also helpful for formulating Poverty Reduction Strategies, Five-Year Plan and Perspective Plan. Data on number of workable and employed male & female labor force, rate of unemployment, rate of youth unemployment are determined through Labor Force Survey. The comprehensive plans for reducing unemployment and labor market development is likely to be undertaken by using those data which directly or indirectly help reduce poverty. In addition, unemployed young sections are employed to collect data on Population Census, Economic Census, Agriculture (Crops, Fisheries & Livestock) Census, Sample Vital registration in digital platform, quarterly Labor Force Survey which have been playing significant role in reducing poverty.

Impact on Women's Advancement: In some cases of field-level data collection, 100% of women are recruited which helps collect more standardized and realistic data related to women. Under the Sample Vital Registration System (SVRS) in Digital Platform and Household Income and Expenditure Survey, 100% of women are temporarily recruited and trained, which plays an important role in women empowerment.

Related Strategic Objectives

1. Conducting census and surveys and publishing results within minimum time frame

Statistics derived from Census and Surveys are used to identify problems in different fields and prepare Development Plans accordingly. Furthermore, these statistics are used to provide public services by various ministries/division. It is extremely important to ensure the accuracy, timeliness and reliability of statistics. Therefore, conducting Census and Surveys timely and publishing results within minimum time has been prioritized.

2. Modernization of National Accounting System and updating price indices base year

Modernization of National Accounting System and updating the base year of price indices are one of the priority areas. These provide detailed information to the policy makers about overall situation of the national economy, which can be used to forecast growth and design development plan. Meanwhile, quarterly GDP has been published.

3. Standardization of statistical procedures and techniques

Government, non-government, national and international development agencies take initiatives to identify problems in development planning, formulate policies and implement plans. For this reason, different agencies collect information from various sources in different ways. Differences in sources and methods of data collection involve cost and time. Standardization of statistical methods has been prioritized to overcome these problems.

4. Expansion of statistical service provider network, creation of a database and establishment of data center

In order to deliver statistical services to the doorstep of people, expansion of the statistical network, establishment of national data bank along with maintaining and updating are inevitable. Thus, these activities are identifying as priority spending areas/programmes.
