### 3.0 Poverty and Gender Reporting

### 3.1 Impact of Strategic Objectives on Poverty Reduction and Women's Advancement

#### 3.1.1 Maintain internal security and law and order

**Impact on Poverty Reduction:** Improvement of internal law and order situation will ensure the security of lives and properties of common people. By ensuring the security of lives and properties of common people, economic activity will expand with a rise in investment. Employment generation will also ensure for the poor. As a result, the gap between rich and poor will gradually decrease which will play a commendable role in poverty reduction.

**Impact on Women's Advancement:** Once security of life and property is ensured, there will be more employment opportunities for women. This will also ensure fair wage and thus, their income will be increased. Women will be more awarded and their role in the society will be more prominent.

# 3.1.2 Border security and smuggling control

**Impact on Poverty Reduction:** Small and medium enterprises of the country cannot sustain as smuggled goods/commodities create uneven competition. As a result, workers are ending up by losing their jobs. If smuggling is stopped, small and medium enterprises will grow and create more jobs which will contribute to poverty reduction. Furthermore, through continuous patrolling in the coastal areas and campaign against piracy, employment opportunities for people depending on the sea will increase. This will have a positive impact on poverty reduction.

# 6.0 Recent Achievements, Activities, Output Indicators and Targets and Expenditure Estimates of the Departments/Agencies

### 6.1 Secretariat

**6.1.1 Recent Achievements**: The Ansar Battalion Act 2023, the Bangladesh Police (Subordinate Staff) Welfare Fund Act 2023 and the Law and Order Disruption (Speedy Trial) (Amendment) Act 2024 have been passed by the Grand National Assembly to bring momentum to crime prevention activities and enhance the capacity of law enforcement agencies. Bangladesh continued its promotion from Tier-02 watch list to Tier-2 as per US State Department report on human trafficking continues. National Referral Mechanism Roadmap for Rescue and Rehabilitation of Human Trafficking Victims is formulated. 4282 new posts have been created in the organizational structure of Border Guard Bangladesh along with the recruitment of 14924 people in various posts of Bangladesh Police. Besides, Digital Arms Management System (DAMS) software has been introduced to modernize arms license renewal and issuance.

### 6.2 Bangladesh Police

**6.2.1 Recent Achievements:** In addition to providing overall security at various assembly and public events held both at the national and local level, Police has maintained law and order and provided security with utmost professionalism during National parliament election, City Corporation elections, Municipal Council elections and Union Council by-elections/general elections. Bangladesh Police is providing quick and easy service to the people through National Emergency Service-999. Over the last three years, country-wide Police operations resulted in the recovery of 4,569 various types of illegal arms; 29,239 round of ammunition; 2,84,323 explosives; 828 kg Heroin; 2,10,558 kg Cannabis; 1,07,772 bottles and 4578 liters of foreign liquor; 1,65957 cans and 18,257 bottles of beer; 8,96,395 bottles and 292 liters of Phensidyl; 10,1528,513 pieces of Yaba tablets; 73.5 kg Opium and huge narcotics items. In the last three years, a total number of 1,471 Bangladesh police personnel have successfully completed Peacekeeping missions.

### 6.5 Bangladesh Coast Guard

**Recent achievements**: Bangladesh Coast Guard (BCG) has seized 95 illegal arms, 580 rounds of live ammunitions, rescued 114 abducted fishermen and 54 boats in last 3 years (2020-2021, 2021-2023 and 2022-2023). 182 peoples of Bangladeshi and FDMN were detained while traveling abroad by sea illegally for Bhasanchar. BCG apprehended illegal products which worth taka 520 crore, and 867 robbers and smugglers were arrested. 06 lac 63 thousand kg Jatka, 160 crore 82 lac mtrs Current Net, 69 crore 67 lac mtrs various net which worth taka 9,695 crore (approx). Moreover, BCG also seized 07 thousand cft various types of illegal timber of about taka 17 crore and 99 lac 22 thousand pieces yaba, 21 thousand bottle/can of various narcotics, 5.9 kg Ice, 228 kg cannabis. Production of Hilsha fish has increased

enormously compared to the past years because of 'Jatka Nidhon Protirod' and 'Ma Ilish Rakkha' operation. Tireless efforts of BCG and its special operations at Chattogram, Mongla and Payra port and outer anchorage area has reduced the piracy/petty theft report to zero.
