### 6.1 Bangladesh Parliament Secretariat

**6.1.1 Recent Achievements:** Telecasting 'Sangshad Bangladesh' TV, constructing a studio and establishing of a Media Centre are some of the notable achievements. Besides, as a part of digitalizing parliamentary activities, computers/laptops with internet connection have been provided to the MPs, Network Core Equipment has been procured and a modern data centre has been established. Management Information System (MIS) has been introduced in order to modernize the daily activities of the Financial Oversight Committees in the Parliament under the Strengthening Parliamentary Oversight (SPO) Project. Total number of 13 bills have been received as well as examined and 126 bills have been placed to the House and have been sent to the concerned parliamentary committees during the period of 2013-14 to 2015-16.
