6.0 Recent Achievements, Activities, Output Indicators and Targets and Expenditure Estimates of the Departments/Agencies

6.1 Armed Forces Division

6.1.1 Recent Achievements: Draft Defence Policy has been prepared and forwarded to the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Ministry of Defence which is now under approval process. Armed Forces Division has played an active role in updating the "War Book". To strengthen and modernize the armed forces 145 modern armaments, necessary ammunitions and equipment's were purchased during the last three years. 2,202 Units of the Defence Forces were deployed to assist the Civil Administration in rehabilitation activities. During the same period, through coordination of 1,631 training programs at home and abroad, 3,874 defence personnel were imparted training. Bangladesh participated in 46 seminars/conferences/ training programs in the implementation of International Chemical Weapons Convention. Besides, 22,237 defence personnel were deployed in various UN peace keeping missions that brought forth a total of US\$ 566.00 million.
