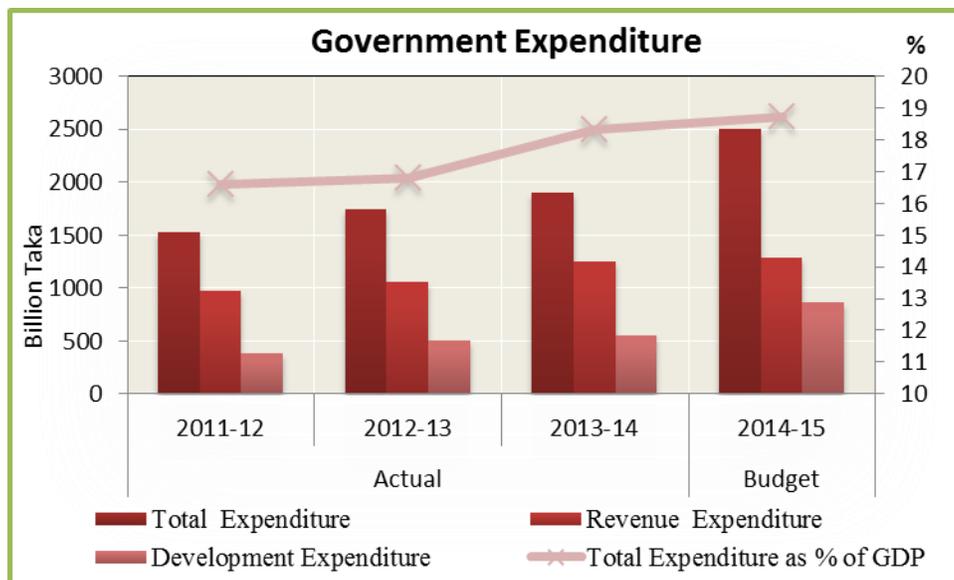




# Monthly Report on Fiscal Position

June 2015  
Fiscal Year 2014-15



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## *Executive Summary*

*Fiscal Report is prepared on monthly basis. It basically contains information on government expenditure, revenue and overall balance. The report is prepared from data generated from the Integrated Budget & Accounting System (iBAS) of the Finance Division, Ministry of Finance. In this report, fiscal year (FY) refers to the period from July 01 to June 30 of the next year. Taka is Local Currency Unit (LCU), and one crore is ten million.*

*Government expenditure is shown under two broad categories, namely, Non-Development Expenditure and Development Expenditure. Total actual non-development spending up to June, 2015 at the end of current fiscal year (FY15) is 84.3 percent of the revised non-development budget estimates. Actual development expenditure during the same period is 89.6 percent of the development budget estimate.*

*Revenue income is generated from tax and non-tax sources. Up to June 2015, 91.5 percent of total revenue target has been achieved. During this period, major share of the revenue came from NBR (National Board of Revenue) taxes (91.8 percent of revised target). Total NBR tax collection is 91.8 percent of the revised annual target. Regarding NTR (Non Tax Revenue) 74.0 percent of the revised annual target has been achieved.*

*Balance (Surplus/Deficit) Overall balance of the budget is calculated either by including grants or by excluding grants. Up to June 2015, in current fiscal, overall balance (excluding grants) is -3.81 percent of the estimated GDP.*

# MONTHLY REPORT ON FISCAL POSITION<sup>1</sup>

## 1.0 NON-DEVELOPMENT EXPENDITURE

### 1.1 NON-DEVELOPMENT EXPENDITURE: GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

#### 1.1.1 SECTOR WISE ALLOCATION & GROWTH

Allocations for non-development expenditure against different Ministries/Divisions are grouped into 14 sectors. Sector-wise utilization pattern along with progress so far made has been presented in **Table 1**.

Some of the noteworthy features are:

- For FY15, revised budget allocations were raised by 10.6 percent over the FY14 revised estimates and 10.1 percent over the original budget
- Up to June 2015, i.e. during FY15 non-development spending in defense sector was the highest and the second highest spending was in housing sector. On the contrary, lowest spending was incurred in general public service sector and the second lowest spending was in social security and welfare sector.
- As a whole, non-development spending for FY15 amounts to 84.3 percent of total Non-development revised budget.

### 1.1.2 Broad Sector wise Allocation

Allocations for non-development expenditure against different ministries/divisions are also classified under six broad categories, namely, administration, social infrastructure, physical infrastructure, agriculture, interest payment and others. Following table contains broad sector-wise information:

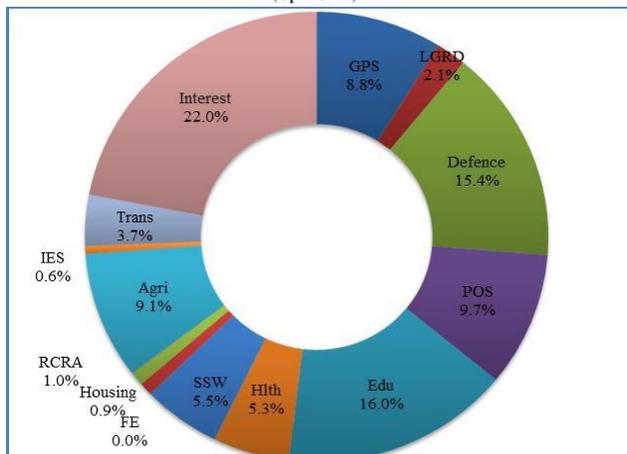

- Broadly in the revised budget for FY15, share of administrative expenditure has increased whereas allocations against all other categories are reduced in comparison to the actual expenditure of FY14. But actual shares for FY15 in administration, social infrastructure, physical infrastructure and others have been increased compared to actual share in FY14 whereas shared decreased in agriculture sector and interest payment.
- Till June 2015, among all categories share of administration was the highest.

### 1.1.3 Sector Share in Resource Utilization

Figure 1: Sector Share in Resource Utilization in FY15 (Up to June)



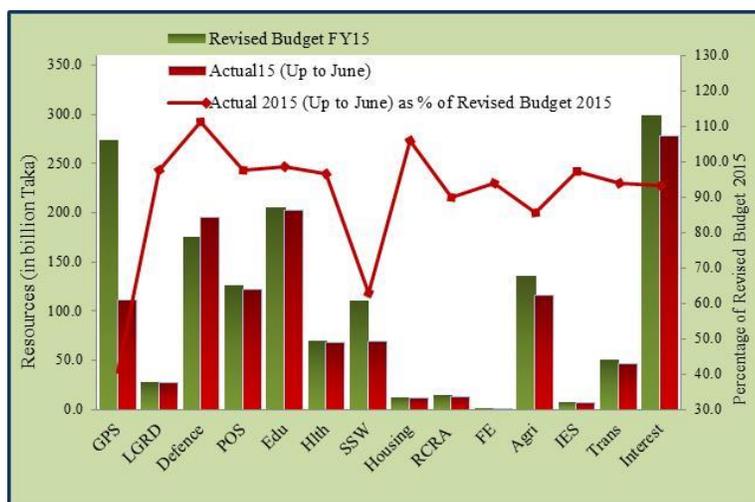
Total non-development spending up to June, 2015 in the current fiscal year is 84.3 percent of the revised budget estimates. Sector-wise share in utilizing resources under non-development expenditure is shown in Figure 1.

- Individually the largest share goes to interest payment (22.0 percent) followed by education (16 percent), defence (15.4 percent), public order and safety (9.7 percent), agriculture (9.1 percent) and general public service (8.8 percent).

### 1.1.4 Sector wise Utilization

Sector-wise utilization pattern of non-development spending up to June, 2015 is shown in **Figure 2**. This figure exhibits the comparative position of different sectors in terms of utilization of allocated resources. In terms of utilization, apart from interest payment, broadly education, defence, agriculture and public order safety have shown better performance. Table containing detail data is annexed as **Appendix 1**.

### 1.1.5 Ministry-wise Utilization

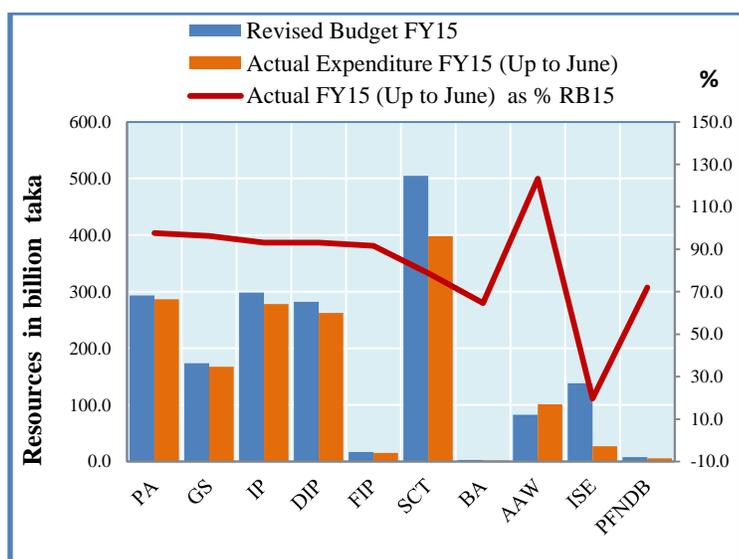
For current 2014-15 fiscal year, actual spending (non-development) up to June, 2015 is 84.3 percent of the revised budget estimate, which is 5.4 percent lower compared with the same period of the previous fiscal year. Ministry-wise utilization pattern of the non-development spending is presented in **Appendix 2**.

### 1.2 Non-Development Expenditure: Economic Classification

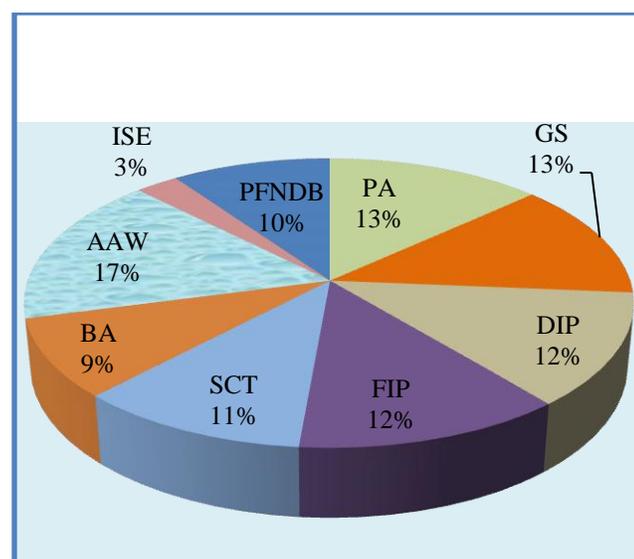
Besides broad sector-wise and ministry-wise classification, non-development spending is also categorized into 08 economic groups, namely, Pay and Allowances (**PA**), Goods & Services (**GS**), Interest Payment (**IP**) [Domestic & Foreign], Subsidies & Current Transfer (**SCT**), Block Allocation (**BA**), Acquisition of Assets and Works (**AAW**), Investment in share & equities (**ISE**), Programme financed from Non-Development Budget (**PFNDB**). Status of actual spending up to June 2015 as per economic classification is shown in **figure 3** and **4**. Detail structure & pattern of Non-development expenditure under this classification is included in the Appendix (**Appendix 3**).

- Up to June 2015, utilization rate of total non-development expenditure is 84.3 percent. As far as economic classification is concerned for some categories, like pay and allowances (97.6 percent), goods and services (96.3 percent), acquisition of assets and works (123.2 percent) and interest payments (93.1 percent) spending rate is higher than overall utilization rate.

## 2.0 DEVELOPMENT EXPENDITURE

### 2.1 ALLOCATION & UTILIZATION PATTERN OF DEVELOPMENT EXPENDITURE

Total allocations against different ministries/divisions for development spending are grouped under 13 broad sectors. Allocation and utilization pattern of **development expenditure**<sup>3</sup> is shown in **Table 3**.

- Up to June 2015, actual expenditure is 74.0 percent of the revised development budget. The actual outturn for the same period of the previous fiscal year was about 92.1 percent of revised budget;
- During the financial year, recreation, culture and religious affairs sector made the highest utilization of allocated resources (98.2 percent) followed by transport and communication sector (94.8 percent)
- Among the sectors with large allocation, transport and communication and local government and rural development (LGRD) sectors showed better performance.

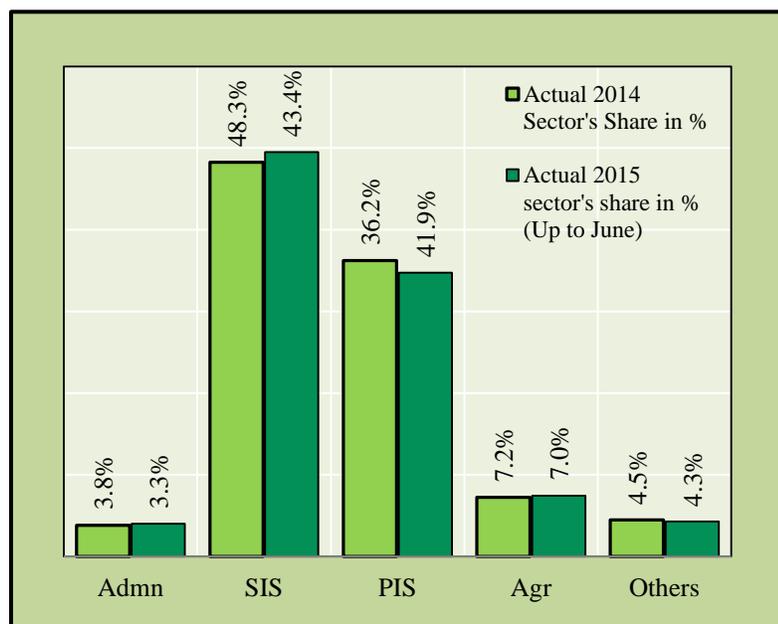
<sup>3</sup> Development Expenditure includes ADP (Annual Development Programme) and Non-ADP FFW (Food for Work) and Transfers. Development expenditure is still under reported in the budgeting information system and it seems there is some time lag between actual expenditure and inputting the same in the system.

## 2.3 BROAD SECTOR WISE UTILIZATION PATTERN

Total development expenditure is further classified under 5 broad categories. Status of actual expenditure under these 5 categories till June, 2015 is presented in Figure 5.

➤ From the graph it appears that up to June, 2015 the maximum share of spending went to social infrastructure (43.4 percent) followed by physical infrastructure (41.9 percent)

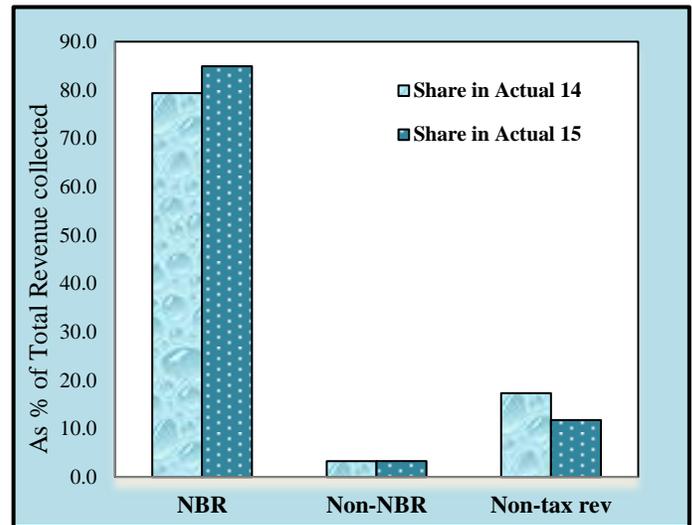

- **Total revenue** collection in FY14 was 10.5 percent of GDP (base 2005-06) and 89.6 percent of the revised budget target
- In FY15, total revenue was expected to be scaled up to 12.1 percent of GDP. This figure is about 16.8 percent higher than the revised budget estimate of FY14 and about 30.3 percent higher than the actual collection in the FY14
- Total revenue collection for FY15 increased by 4.0 percent compared to that of the previous fiscal year (FY14) and achievement as to the revised budget is 89.3 percent.

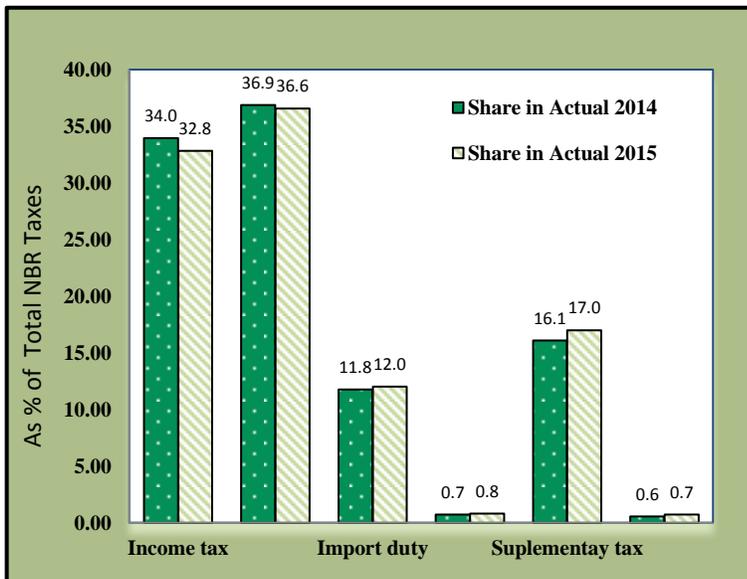
- Major share of the government revenue comes from NBR sources (84.9 percent);
- During FY15 Growth rates of NBR & Non-NBR tax are 11.3 and 4.6 percent respectively. On the other hand, Non-tax revenue collection slowed by 29.4 percent compared to the previous fiscal year (FY14);
- For tax and non-tax revenue, achievements as to revised annual target were 91.5 and 75.7 percent respectively.

- In FY14 actual tax revenue collection was 8.6 percent of GDP
- Tax revenue collection target for FY15 was 10.3 percent of GDP. Against this target actual collection during FY15 is 8.5 percent of GDP.
- During FY15, major portion of the NBR tax comes from indirect taxes. Out of total NBR tax 32.8 percent was collected from income tax, 36.6 percent from VAT, 17.0 percent from supplementary duty and 12.0 percent from import duty.

- In FY14, actual budget deficit (excluding grants) as percentage of GDP was 3.56 percent (base 2005-06). Including grants it was 3.09 percent of GDP;
- Budget deficit (excluding grants) for FY15 was estimated to be 4.46 percent of GDP and Including grants the deficit is expected to be 4.05 percent of GDP. Against this target the actual budget deficit for FY15 is 3.81 percent of GDP (excluding grants).

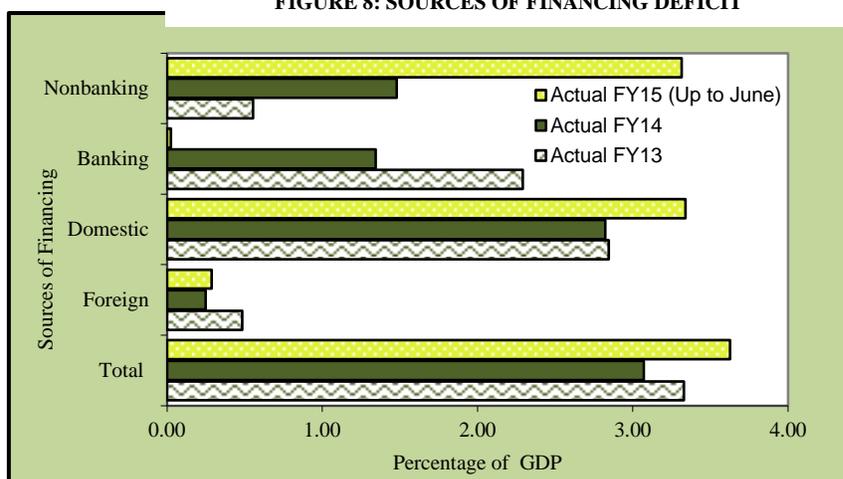
