Allocations and Activities

1 The main functions of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs are:

- a. Maintaining good bilateral diplomatic relations with different countries including neighbors;
- b. Maintaining liaison and co-ordination with foreign countries and United Nations, international, regional and multilateral organizations, holding dialogue/discussion, signing agreements/treaties to play effective roles at the regional and international levels for peace, security and development;
- c. Providing various assistance including consular and other welfare services to expatriate Bangladeshi's through diplomatic and consular representations and overall management of Bangladesh's Missions abroad and ensuring coordination of all matters relating to foreign relations with different Ministries/Divisions in the country;
- d. Coordination between the functions of different Ministries/Divisions and Bangladesh's Missions abroad on matters relating to land and sea boundary and the continental shelf of Bangladesh and resolving associated issues;
- e. Organizing foreign tours of the Hon'ble President and the Hon'ble Prime Minister with all protocol arrangements and management of tours of visiting Heads of foreign States and Governments including other state rituals and providing protocol services to foreign diplomats, consular missions; and diplomatic and consular representatives of other countries stationed in Bangladesh;
- f. Taking actions to repatriate forcedly displaced Myanmar citizens in Bangladesh safely to their home country and ensuring constructive roles in all contemporary regional/global issues relating to climate change, international migration and overall non-traditional national security;
- 9. External publicity and pursuing people-oriented diplomacy to present Bangladesh as a secular, democratic and progressive state in the global forums:
- h. Protection and promotion of interest of the citizens of Bangladesh living abroad in relation to education, culture, trade and commerce etc. and ensuring welfare of the Bangladeshi expatriates.

- Undertaking different activities to observe the birth centenary of Bangabandhu in the Headquarters and worldwide Bangladesh 's Missions abroad to enhance the image and soft-power of Bangladesh;
- c. Enactment of legislation to ensure the claim of the Continental Self demanded by Bangladesh, to take necessary measures and to ensure proper utilization of sea resources;
- d. Taking effective multilateral and bilateral diplomatic actions to repatriate the Myanmar Citizens forcedly displaced in Bangladesh to their home country;
- e. Formulating and implementing the Action Plans to face all challenges related to the transition from LDC status to Developing Nation;
- f. Organizing bilateral and multilateral tours of the Hon'ble President and Hon'ble Prime Minister in important countries and arranging visits of the Heads of State and Government of different countries;
- 9. Explore the fields of international cooperation including the potentiality of Blue Economy and take effective steps to take out natural resources in the sea:
- h. Cooperating the countries interested in investment in nuclear power plant, renewable energy based on solar, windmill and thermal power plant:
- i. Create public opinion on the interest of the countries on climate risk and play an active role in preserving Bangladesh's interests in other multilateral forums including the Climate Vulnerable Forum-CVF; and
- j. In addition to the construction of the own multi-storied building of the Foreign Ministry; purchase of properties in Kuala Lumpur, Athens, Singapore and Cairo.
