Allocations and Activities

- 1 The main functions of the Energy and Mineral Resources Division:
- a. Updating and implementing National Energy Policy;
- b. Conducting geological survey, coastal geological and geomorphologic mapping, identification & economic assessment of valuable mineral in river sands;
- c. Increasing natural gas reserve through well drilling and exploring, extracting, transmitting and distributing natural gas throughout the country:
- d. Signing Production Sharing Contracts (PSC) with international gas and oil exploration companies;
- e. Importing and marketing of oil and petroleum products as per the demand of the country;
- f. Ensuring effective enforcement of Explosive Act and its related rules and regulations; and
- g. Developing skilled human resources in the Energy Sector.
- 2 The revised budget allocation [Operating and Development] from FY 2015-16 to FY 2017-18 and the proposed allocation [Operating and Development] for FY 2018-19 of the Energy and Mineral Resources Division are shown below:

- 3 In FY 2018-19, the following important activities/projects/programmers are scheduled to be implemented:
- a. Drilling of 4(Four) work over wells to increase the production of gas;
- b. Expansion of 54 k. m transmission pipeline to the various areas of the country to supply the gas produced in the North-East zone of the country and the importable LNG and add to the national grid after regassification;
- c. Production of 755 million liters petroleum products [except NGL]as petrol, diesel, octane and kerosene by condensate fractionation from various gas fields:
- d. Production of 25.45 million liters NGL by condensate fractionation from various gas fields;
- e. Execution of 3000 line kilometers 2-D seismic and 550 square kms 3-D seismic survey by BAPEX and IOC to discover new gas fields;
- f. Increasing refining capacity of ERL from 1.5 million MT to 4.5 million MT, construction of Chittagong-Dhaka white oil pipeline, construction of Jet A-1 pipeline from Pitolgoni to Hazarot Shahjalal International Airport;
- g. Construction of pipeline in the Bay of Bengal near Moheshkhali island to unload crude oil & diesel directly from mother vessel;
- h. Extraction of .0.6 Million Metric ton coal from coal mine of Barapukuria Coal Mining Company Limited and 1.00 million Metric ton granite from granite mine of Maddhapara Granite Mining Company Limited;
- i. Establishment of One compressor/gas station to address decrease of the pressure of the gas field;
- j. Ensure the efficient use of natural gas by setting up 95125 prepaid/EVC meters;
- k. Construction of Floating Storage Re-gasification Unit to import LNG in order to meet the ongoing gas crisis.; and
- I. Introduction of Online billing system, CNG auto billing system, hotline system, online response system and online recruitment system by the distribution companies under Petrobangla
